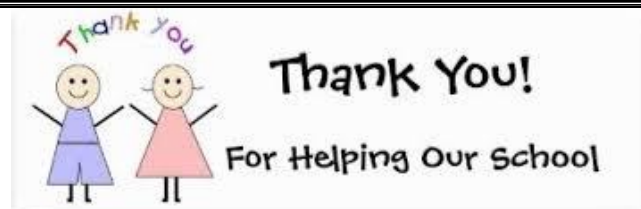


Ambassador Mission...TO INSPIRE AND EDUCATE!
