

## Kindergarten – Second Grade Uniform Requirement Details

- Yellow solid color polo top (NO LOGOS).
- Navy Blue solid color polo top (NO LOGOS).
- Camisoles/T-shirt may be worn in the same color as the shirt—these must be tucked in.
- Solid color khaki, beige, or navy blue uniform bottoms.
- Black or brown belt worn at all times. Shirts must be tucked in for belt to be seen.
- Shorts/Dresses/Skirts/Skortts must be knee length or longer.

## Third - Fifth Grade Uniform Requirement Details

- Light blue solid color polo top (NO LOGOS).
- Navy Blue solid color polo top (NO LOGOS).
- Camisoles/T-shirt may be worn in the same color as the shirt—these must be tucked in.
- Solid color khaki, beige, or navy blue uniform bottoms.
- Black or brown belt worn at all times. Shirts must be tucked in for belt to be seen.
- Shorts/Dresses/Skirts/Skortts must be knee length or longer.

## Sixth - Eighth Grade Uniform Requirement Details

- Dark Purple solid color polo top (Light purple is prohibited - NO LOGOS).
- Black solid color polo top (NO LOGOS).
- Camisoles/T-shirt may be worn in the same color as the shirt—these must be tucked in.
- Solid color black, khaki, beige, or navy blue uniform bottoms.
- Black or brown belt worn at all times. Shirts must be tucked in for belt to be seen.
- Shorts/Dresses/Skirts/Skortts must be knee length or longer.

## \*\*\*General Uniform Requirements\*\*\*

### Regarding Outerwear Garments-

- No pullovers, coats, windbreakers, jackets, raincoats, or hoodies may be worn during school.
- **ONLY a solid color navy blue button down sweater, pullover sweatshirt, or sweater vest may be worn in school over uniform top.**
- NO LOGOS, PICTURES, HOODS, POCKETS, OR ZIPPERS are allowed to be on uniformed outerwear garments.

### Footwear-

\*Please note: all restraints regarding footwear are for the safety of our students while they are on the AALC campus.

- Flip flops or open toe sandals are NOT permitted.
- Heels over 2” are NOT permitted.
- Steel toe boots are NOT permitted.
- House shoes with hard and/or soft bottoms are NOT permitted.

## Casual Regular Dress Day:

Throughout the school year AALC students will have various opportunities to express their own personal style by participating in the specified casual regular dress days. The school calendar will specify those days.

## Uniform Referrals

Please ensure your child is in the proper AALC uniform attire each day unless it is a specified casual regular dress day. If the uniform code is violated, the student will receive a referral and parents will be notified to bring the appropriate uniform for their child.

## High School Dress Code:
